K4 Animal Board



Mrs. Delawder's K4 class has an adorable animal board hanging up in the K4 hallway. This project is an exposure to concepts. The animal boards have a day side and a night side.

The animals on the day side are active in the daytime and the animals on the night side are active at night. During the fall, the students painted the animals and they added fall leaves, apples and pumpkins. They have now moved to winter with snowflakes, snowmen, hibernating animals, etc. In Spring, the babies come out. The students make birds and add nests, blossoms for trees and leaves, flowers, etc. They talk about the life cycle of frogs and birds.
